The artists/authors give a story account of each of the rugs, making them conversation pieces as well. And while this is a book of patterns for 'rugs,' many of these would make great wall hangings or table runners. Well, there is one problem with this book - you will have to decide which rug to knit first.

I can't wait to start knitting several of these rugs! I have a large "craft/design studio" in my home and everything has a knitting theme. Will be making several for that room. One of my favorites is an oval of leaves, it is by far one of the most innovative designs I've seen in a long time. That will go in front of the fireplace. You will not be disappointed! Great for using the cheap acrylic yarns which will take a good amount of wear and tear.

This is a terrific, well written book. The instructions are concise and helpful, which is wonderful when thinking about tackling the more esoteric projects.
