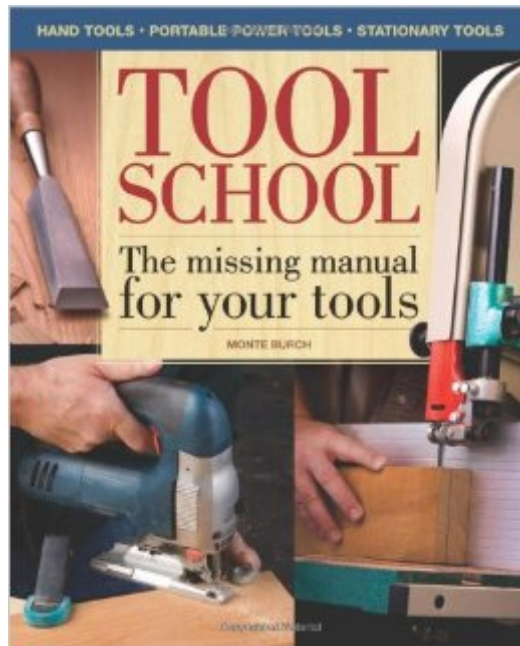

## Customer Reviews

This book is certainly not what the subtitle says, "The missing manual for your tools." Rather, it's a loose collection of mostly superficial descriptions of various tools and their functions. It might be useful for beginners, but certainly not for anyone with even a moderate familiarity with woodworking. Many of the "instructions" in the book are in the form of mini-reviews of various tools. This makes the book more of a buying guide than an instructional manual-- and it means the book will become obsolete as new tool models are introduced. The good news is that it is a very attractive, well-made book. The pictures are large and clear, the paper is heavy and glossy, and the binding is easy-to-use and durable spiral wire. So, in summary: Attractively presented and potentially useful information for beginners, but likely to disappoint anyone with even minimal experience.
