

SSIS allows you to extract, transform and load (ETL) data. The tool can be used by a variety of users (developers, DBAs, and casual users) and at various levels of expertise. The introduction highlights the importance of SSIS in transforming and moving data, in a speedy manner. Compared with other related products (e.g. Informatica and DataStage), SSIS is cheap, in that it comes free with SQL Server - similar products can cost many thousands of dollars. The book's initial chapters are aimed at developers that are new to SSIS, while the later chapters contain patterns and practices targeted at more experienced developers. Chapter 1 Welcome to SQL Server Integration Services The chapter starts with a short history of SSIS, with its roots in Data Transformation Services (DTS), evolving into SSIS in SQL Server 2005. Each successive new version of SQL Server typically adding new features and enhanced functionality, this was especially so of SQL Server 2012. The Import and Export Wizard is introduced as an entry point into SSIS, allowing simple movement and transformation of data. For more complex solutions, SQL Server Data Tools (SSDT) is used, this is where most SSIS work is done.
