it skips around a lot instead of focusing on one thing at a time, like "telling time", so that they really get practice. This is just daily testing on a bunch of different skills all at once. They don't get the practice! I threw ours away and ordered a math book through Teacher Created Resources, which you can purchase on , and I love it!

My daughter just started grade 1 and she likes this book. The problem is that there aren't enough material in this book. The student is supposed to do one exercise per day with this book. But my daughter can do the exercises within a couple seconds. I mean look at day 1. The exercise is to add 4 + 1, with a picture of 4 birds on one side and one bird on the other. Any grade 1 student should be able to count to 5 within a couple of seconds right?So I ended up letting her do the exercises for the whole week per day. Even after a weeks worth of exercise, my daughter would still like to continue.

So for \$10, this book would last only a few weeks. Not the entire school year the author intended it to. This book would easily become 5 stars if the author adds more materials. Much more!

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
