

Was hoping for one or two more survival knots and tool wraps but this is a good book for beginners who'd like to decorate themselves or gift their friends with bracelets. Dog collars and lanyards are the closest thing to "dude related" projects in the book, the rest are bracelets, hair ties, a coffee cup holder and a yoga mat sling. The color photos are great for those of you new to this; basic survival bracelet pattern included as well.

This has pretty basic projects and is a good place to start. The para-cord shown doesn't seem too large, however the para-cord I used makes items like bracelets way too thick. Even the guys I know think they are too large and cumbersome. Use a smaller cording. Just my opinion!

I've been wanting to get started on this for some time, and this book is very detailed, colorfully illustrated, and gives step-by-step instructions on how to create some really cool projects.

I'd suggest ordering another book (Paracord Fusion Ties for instance). The drawings aren't really clear on some areas and should use pictures instead. It's got some nice ideas, but I'd suggest springing a few extra dollars for something a little better.
