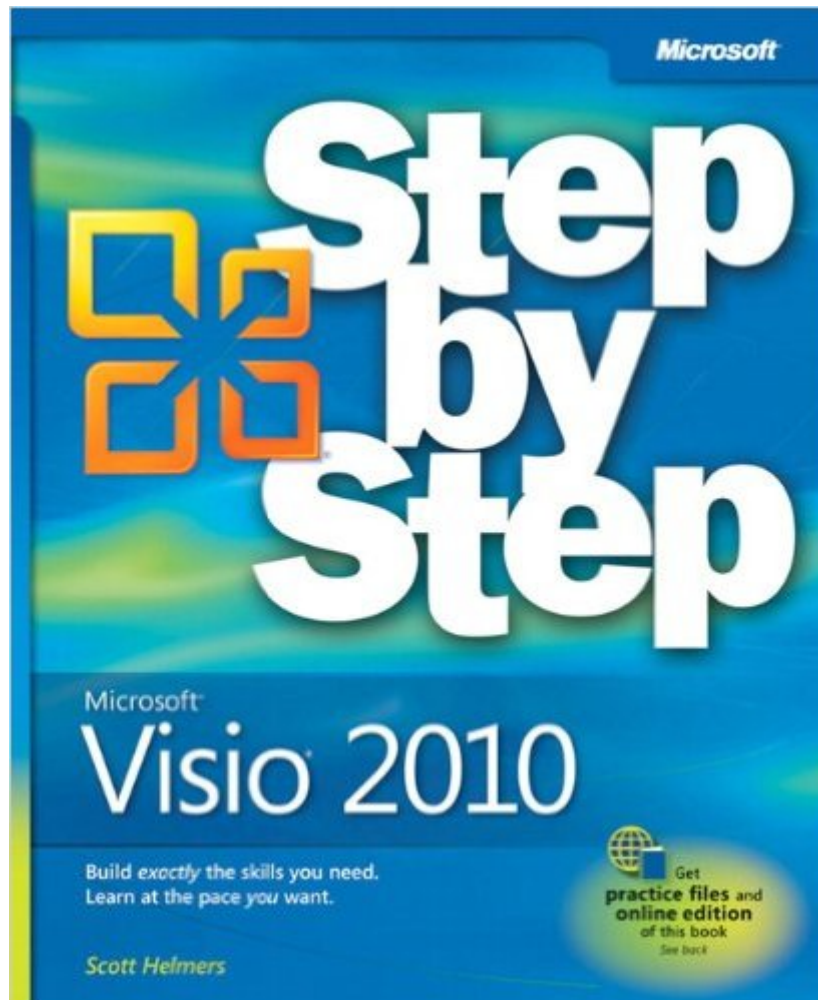

Normally I don’t buy how to software books, as the material value is useless when the next release comes out. The information in this book had all the vocabulary needed to use the program, working examples that will exceed the next version release, and saved my frustration with the Visio software. I watched all those Visio Guy films at Microsoft’s website, and I thought they were great and imaginative, yet when I wanted to work with Visio beyond playing with its interface, those videos weren’t of much help. This book opens the software secrets up quick, and gets you into production. Far less wordy than the dummy books, and the author’s experience and examples will transcend

the next release.

This book is truly a step-by-step tutorial to learn by, with good screen shots and explanation. It is a bit slow to do, but that is what a novice would need. Some authors tend to be a bit lazy and do not bother to show the result of steps, but not Scott Helmers. I am so glad I bought it, and my learning progressed well.

This is one of the best software manual and reference book that I have used. With all the changes to Visio 2010 it was a great source of information both in the book and through the internet references in the book. The book has both a thorough level of detail on the program, tricks to watch out for and whether a feature was new or enhanced or renamed. It also made sure you knew what version of Visio 2010 that a feature exists in. This was especially handy. The book also makes mention of renamed features in the 2010 version of Visio. The author certainly knows his stuff.

I'll add a few comments that might help. First, this version (2010) is very much applicable to Visio 2013. (I bought it because there weren't any Visio 2013 books available yet.) Many of you may know that Kindle versions sometimes don't work well for how-to books. However, I found the Kindle version to be very usable in this case. One negative for me personally was wading through the exercises, step-by-step to better understand the rationale of the topic. Of course, this should be expected from a book that has the words "step-by-step" in the title. (Thus my reason for still giving it five stars.) Also, if you are already familiar with Office 2007 or later, much of the material is redundant. Nevertheless, the exercises move quickly. It has clear writing with a good economy of words.

I purchased the kindle version through [Amazon](#) and the links listed in the book no longer work so I wasn't able to download the practice files. There isn't an ISBN number so I was not able to register the book to get the bonus content. Very disappointed.

Great book to help learn Visio. Visio has a lot of features that you don't always know about or are hard to find in the newer versions. I use it a lot for Value Stream Mapping (VSM) and integrating shape reports and shape data into my VSM's. A must have if you have had little screen time with Visio and need a tool to help you learn. It covers the Premium version (Data tab) very well.

I'm very disappointed that this book does not address enough features in the Professional version. For example, I would love to learn how to make use case diagrams or entity relationship diagrams. This book is not the worst on the market. However, it has HUGE ROOM for improvement.

I had a very disappointing Experience. After receiving the book I was unable to download the files from on-line. Last time I purchased the Step by Step books was the 2007 version and it came w/ CD's to download the classes which was awesome. The 2010 version does NOT come with Cd's, you have to down load classes on-line. I tried several times to download the classes and came up with blank files. What's worse, there's no Customer Service phone # where you can talk to someone. The only option you have it to email Customer Service for help. After sending emails back/forth .. I give up. I can't reach a human! I got not where. What are you do? You throw the books away, waste your money, and find find another product that works.
